

SUMMARY OF IMBA POSITION ON SENATOR BOXER'S CA WILDERNESS BILL

Most recent update: 4/18/2005

Explanation of IMBA Position field:

"**Yes**" means that IMBA could accept the proposal as originally proposed or as amended.

"**Boundary Adjustment Needed**" means that IMBA does not yet support this area for Wilderness, but if a boundary is adjusted we could offer that support.

"**Support Alternative Protection Tool**" means that there are bicycling trails through the middle of the area, or there are many bicycling trails, and IMBA cannot accept any new Wilderness in this area. However, IMBA definitely supports protecting the area from development using legal designations similar to Wilderness.

"**Insufficient Information**" means the we don't yet know about bicycling opportunities in the area.
